LEGAL SUPPORT

- Resolving identity theft
- Re-entering foster care (youth 18 - 21) AB-12
- Clearing juvenile tickets
- Sealing juvenile records
- Requesting name changes from the Court
- Emancipation
- Accessing SSI and SILP benefits



HOUSING

- Determining Eligibility
- Applying for housing programs
- Advocating on behalf of clients
- Problem solving with clients to identify temporary housing options
- Connecting with clients who were formerly in care to the Coordinated Entry System



TRANSITIONING TO ADULTHOOD

- Connecting youth to high school completion (G.E.D) programs, college campuses, financial aid, and scholarship programs
- Accessing Medi-Cal coverage
- Connecting youth to training programs and employment
- Mentor connection
- Becoming a Young Leader and Advocate
